The Armed Man Suite by Sir Karl Jenkins is an iconic short Mass. It blends western classical and eastern musical styles and is a powerful account of the search for peace. The whole Mass was first performed in 2000 by the London Philharmonic Orchestra and National Youth Choir. The Suite is a condensed version of the Mass, more suitable for groups and days like ours.
