

'Let's sing together day': Haydn's Creation

Our new season of events for 2026 begins with our next 'Let's sing together' day on Saturday 14 March. We hold these twice a year so that singers can come together to sing a musical piece from scratch in a day.

In March we will be singing from Haydn's 'Creation'. This is a joyful and exuberant work, from which we will sing the Choruses that mark each day of the Creation. The Rev Chris Bunce (vicar of St Mary's, Hitchin) will help set the scene by reading an edited version of the libretto. We are delighted to have three soloists joining us, along with Richard Carr on the organ. The day will run from 10am to 5pm with breaks (BYO lunch). There is also an optional rehearsal on Saturday 7 March in Knebworth for those who want to be reminded of the music beforehand. We will be using the old Novello edition of the score.

The day finishes with a free informal performance at 4pm to which all are invited.
